Mass Heater Chulha

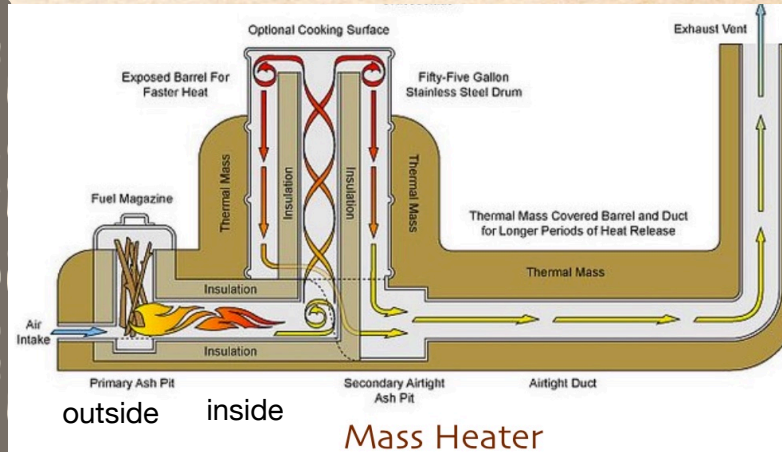
Comforts for the brahmanas are secondary and comfort of the cows is Krishna's first concern SB 10.8.16



Heater enters goshala through a wall to a barrel (under the stairs) that radiates heat. Pipes along the wall warm sleep area.

Heater intake/feeder is outside for fire safety. The intake is a chulha stove with 2 burners for boiling water, milk or tea. Mass heaters are 90% fuel efficient, can burn kid-collected sticks

Simple wood structure covers outside area (approx. 80 sq. feet). Bigger shed can be built over top, complementary to barn style.
